### What's happening in the Garden?

- Deadheading your annuals will keep them blooming beautifully all season long.
- If your container plants need a boost, give them weekly fertilization with water soluble fertilizer. Once the roots are fully established, switch to an enhancer to promote extra flowers and color all summer.
- Fertilize all of your perennials once more and remember, it is best not to continue to fertilize past August 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Applying a grub control product containing Merit in early July will kill up to 90% of the grubs as they hatch, effectively preventing a whole generation of grubs from ever being able to cause any damage to your yard.



## KRAFT.COM RECIPE OF THE MONTH Lemonade Stand Pie



**Prep Time:** 15 min

**Total Time:** 4 hr 15 min

**Makes:** 8 servings

✓1/3 cup COUNTRY TIME  
Lemonade Flavor Drink Mix

✓1/2 cup cold water

✓2 cups vanilla ice cream, softened

✓1 tub (8 oz.) COOL WHIP Whipped  
Topping, thawed

✓1 HONEY MAID Graham Pie Crust  
(6 oz.)

**PLACE** drink mix in large bowl. Add water; stir until mix is dissolved. Add ice cream. Beat with electric mixer on low speed until well blended. Gently stir in whipped topping. Freeze, if necessary, until mixture is thick enough to mound.

**SPOON** into crust.

**FREEZE** at least 4 hours or overnight until firm. Remove from freezer 15 min. before serving. Let stand at room temperature until pie can easily be cut. Store leftover pie in freezer.
