*Strawberry Delight
 Squares*



Makes: 20 servings, 1 square each

What You Need!
 1-1/2 cups finely crushed HONEY MAID Honey Grahams (about 10 grahams)
 1/2 cup sugar, divided
 6 Tbsp. butter or margarine, melted
 1-1/2 pkg. (8 oz. each) PHILADELPHIA 1/3 Less Fat than Cream Cheese, softened
 2 Tbsp. milk
 1 cup thawed COOL WHIP LITE Whipped Topping
 2 cups boiling water
 1 pkg. (8-serving size) JELL-O Strawberry Flavor Sugar Free Gelatin
 1-1/2 cups cold water
 2 cans (8-1/4 oz. each) mandarin orange segments, drained

Make It!
MIX graham crumbs, 1/4 cup of the sugar and the butter. Press firmly onto bottom of 13x9-inch pan. Set aside.
BEAT cream cheese, remaining 1/4 cup sugar and the milk in medium bowl with wire whisk until well blended. Stir in whipped topping; spread over crust. Refrigerate until ready to use. Meanwhile, stir boiling water into dry gelatin in large bowl at least 2 minutes until completely dissolved. Stir in cold water. Refrigerate 1-1/2 hours or until thickened (spoon drawn through leaves definite impression). Stir in oranges. Spoon over cream cheese layer.
REFRIGERATE 3 hours or until firm. Cut into 20 squares to serve. Store leftover dessert in refrigerator.
