It's also a good idea to check that all insulation is intact and all skirting is securely attached. If you are leaving for the winter have your pipes winterized and notify Universal Utilities at 800-788-8287.

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Double Layer Pumpkin Cheesecake



Recipe Rating:
 Prep Time: 10 min
 Total Time: 3 hr 50 min
 Makes: 8 servings

- 2 pkg. (8 oz. each)
 PHILADELPHIA Fat Free
 Cream Cheese, softened
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1/2 tsp. vanilla
- 2 eggs
- 1/2 cup canned pumpkin
- 1/4 tsp. ground cinnamon
- Dash ground nutmeg
- 1/3 cup HONEY MAID
 Graham Cracker Crumbs
- 1/2 cup thawed COOL
 WHIP FREE Whipped
 Topping

MIX cream cheese, sugar
 and vanilla with electric
 mixer on medium speed
 until well blended. Add eggs;
 mix until blended. Do not
 overbeat after adding eggs.
 Remove 1 cup batter; stir in
 pumpkin and spices. Spray
 9-inch pie plate with cooking
 spray; sprinkle bottom with
 crumbs. POUR remaining
 plain batter into crust. Top
 with pumpkin batter. BAKE
 at 325°F for 40 minutes or
 until center is almost set.
 Cool. Refrigerate 3 hours or
 overnight. Top each serving
 with 1 Tbsp. of the whipped
 topping.
